

**Pahang BN Replaces Three Candidates**

KUANTAN, April 18 (Bernama) -- Three Pahang Barisan Nasional candidates announced on Tuesday, have been replaced with three new names, said Pahang BN chairman Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob today.

The changes involve the parliamentary seat of Lipis and two state seats, Padang Tengku and Bebar.

"The process of replacement was carried out after listening to the views of many parties including the grassroots," he told reporters before a closed-door session with Pahang BN candidates at the Pahang Foundation Complex, here, today.

Padang Tengku incumbent, Datuk Abdul Rahman Mohamad will be contesting the the Lipis parliamentary seat, replacing the earlier candidate, Datuk Shahrom Osman who is also the incumbent.

Abdul Rahman's place in Padang Tengku will be taken over by the Pahang MB's special officer, Datuk Mustapa Long.

The incumbent of Peramu Jaya who was earlier named as the candidate for the Bebar state seat, Ibrahim Awang Ismail will be replaced by a new face, Mohd Fakhrudin Mohd Arif, who is a Pekan Umno division committee member.
