

**Don't Take The Opponent's Ability Lightly - Najib

PEKAN, April 20 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has called on all BN election machinery to work hard and not to take lightly the capability of the opponents in the 13th general election (GE13).

The Prime Minister said that only hard work could ensure that the BN achieved a bigger majority in the polls.

Najib said the BN machinery should not look down on the capability of the opposition even if the particular opponent was not a local resident.

"The efforts of the machinery workers are crucial in order to obtain a bigger majority from the previous general election, they need to work day and night to explain to the constituents on the transformations implemented by the BN-led government," he said in his speech when visiting the Tanjung Medang Polling District Centre (PDM), here Saturday.

The PDM in the Bebar state constituency was the first visited by Najib after the nomination process for the GE13 at the Sultan Ahmad Shah Convention Hall this morning.

Najib also called on all voters in the Bebar state constituency to support the new candidate contesting in the state constituency.

"I believe the new candidate (Mohammad Fakhruddin Mohd Ariff) can provide similar services and contribution as the previous assemblyman because he brings continuity from the previous leadership," he said.

He said that with solid support for the new candidate, all forms of development and transformation that the government intended to bring to the state constituency could be achieved.

Mohammad Fakhruddin will face the PKR candidate, Mohd Jafri Ab Rashid.
