

**Former Taman Guru PKR Chief Rallies Behind BN

KUANTAN, April 20 (Bernama) -- The Taman Guru Parti Keadilan Rakyat (PKR) branch chief who recently announced he had dumped the party, has apparently thrown his support behind the Barisan Nasional (BN).

Baharin Mokhtar, who cited disillusionment with PKR vice-president Fuziah Salleh's leadership, was seen with several BN supporters accompanying BN candidate Datuk Mohamed Suffian Awang to the nomination centre at Blok C, Dewan Jabatan Agama Islam Pahang here Saturday.

Fuziah is the incumbent member of parliament for the Kuantan seat, having won it in the 12th general election.

Bahrain, who had been with the PKR for 10 years, urged opposition supporters to realise the futility of hanging on to the party.

"There is nothing to look forward to the opposition. If we continue to hang on to it, we will only face frustrations as the party (PKR) only belongs to certain people," he said.

Meanwhile, Mohamed Suffian, who is Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak's political secretary, hoped more PKR supporters would join the BN and support the prime minister's transformation agenda which would ensure prosperity for the people.
