

**Make Wise Decision To Elect A Government With Vision And Mission For Nation,
Says Muhyiddin

KUALA LUMPUR, April 20 (Bernama) -- Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today urged Malaysians from all strata of society to make an objective evaluation and a wise decision to elect a government that has a vision and mission for the nation.

In this regard, the Deputy Prime Minister appealed to the people to give solid support to Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates in the May 5 general election because the coalition aspired to boost the people's well-being and propel the nation to excellence.

"We've the aspiration and vision to uplift the people's integrity and dignity and take this blessed nation to greater heights.

"I hope this general election and the campaign will go on smoothly without any untoward incidents. A chaotic situation is not an election culture in this country until polling day.

"So, it's important that the election process proceeds undisrupted. God willing, the BN will secure the people's mandate to form the next government.

"Definitely, a victory will be very meaningful to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak. I hope Najib will be re-elected again in Pekan to lead the nation as the prime minister," he said when interviewed live by TV3 from Pagoh.

Muhyiddin is the BN candidate for the Pagoh parliamentary seat in Johor.

Muhyiddin, who is also BN deputy chairman, said the coalition's election machinery would rally behind BN contestants to ensure victory in the state and parliamentary constituencies.

A total of 222 parliamentary and 505 state seats are up for grabs in this election.

"The next two weeks are a crucial period for the BN election machinery to work hard to win the people's hearts and minds.

This general election is very important. "We want the BN government's hardwork to be known to the people so that they will know the BN's struggles for the people and country.

"The machinery will provide solid support and work round-the-clock to ensure victory for BN aspirants," he said.

Earlier, Muhyiddin handed his nomination papers for his "signature" Pagoh parliamentary seat at the Pagoh Sports Complex at 9.30am.

He is again facing the same PAS candidate, Mohd Rozali Jamil, whom he defeated in the 2008 general election.

Muhyiddin hoped the people would read and understand the meaning and the gist of the BN manifesto which promised progress and prosperity to the people.

He also expressed satisfaction that the nomination process proceeded smoothly country-wide.

"Election Commission officials discharged their duties diligently in handling the nomination procedures. There were no problems whatsoever," he added.
