

BN's financial analysis of Pakatan's manifesto inaccurate, says Rafizi

PETALING JAYA, April 15 — PKR's Rafizi Ramli today rebutted Barisan Nasional's (BN)'s allegedly "misleading" analysis of Pakatan Rakyat's (PR) manifesto, while claiming that he had a copy of the confidential document that was leaked to him.

The PKR strategy director explained that the financial projections by BN had left out the potential savings that would be made by a PR administration.\

Rafizi (picture) claimed that BN had "purposely fudged" its numbers to arrive at the conclusion that PR will incur a budget deficit of 13.2 per cent of the country's GDP, saying that the estimates of higher expenditure and lower revenues for a PR government were wrong.

"I will show in the next few days that both estimates, the estimates of cost of our programme is wrong and the estimate that we will get less revenue is also wrong," he said at a press conference at the PKR headquarters here.
