

Kita supports Najib's call

KUALA LUMPUR: Parti Kesejahteraan Insan Tanah Air (Kita) has welcomed Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Razak's recent advice to the opposition not to take to the streets if they lose in the next general election.

Its president, Zamil Ibrahim, said the Pakatan Rakyat coalition should realise that the majority of Malaysians do not support them.

"The rakyat fully reject a leader who has no morals, is a serial liar, pro-Israel, pro-LGBT and holds on to the belief of religious pluralism.

"For obvious reasons, Malays and Muslims reject Anwar and PKR unanimously over the use of the word "Allah" and the issue of religious pluralism," he told the New Sunday Times.

He stressed that opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim should not use these issues as a political tool although he had the support of Pas spiritual leader Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat on the issues.

"Malaysia has laws that have to be adhered to by everyone, including those who are power-crazy and irresponsible. Religion, the country's security and its sovereignty is above politics, so please do not abuse them," urged Zamil.
