

**Anwar 'a liability to Pas'**

KUALA LUMPUR: Opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's moral issues and sex scandals have become a huge liability for Pas to bear.

Parti Kesejahteraan Insan Tanah Air (Kita) former leader Zamil Ibrahim said this was the reason support for the de facto leader had been "declining" among Pas leaders and members.

He said he was told by Pas members, whom he declined to name, that many Pas supporters left Stadium Merdeka when Anwar delivered his speech on Saturday at the Kuala Lumpur rally.

"It's clear that he has lost the support of almost all Pas members when they have unanimously rejected Anwar to be made prime minister if the opposition wins the coming general election."

Zamil claimed he was told by a source in PKR that Anwar had to persuade his wife, PKR president Datuk Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail and daughter and vice-president Nurul Izzah Anwar, to accompany Shamsidar Taharin, wife of party deputy president Azmin Ali, to be a key witness in a defamation suit against him.
