

**'Najib factor' wins them over**

HULU SELANGOR: More than 1,000 opposition supporters here have declared their support for the Barisan Nasional government since BN took over the constituency in 2010.

Hulu Selangor member of parliament P. Kamalanathan said the people attributed their decision to jump ship to the "Najib factor".

"Hulu Selangor is a classic example. The opposition won the constituency in 2008 but they did not do anything for the people here. When BN took over, people saw the changes that took place and realised that the opposition is just full of empty promises," he said after launching the Prihatin 1Malaysia programme in Taman Bunga Raya here yesterday.

He said the opposition had during the 2008 election made many promises, like giving free water and assistance to preschool children, but nothing was implemented.

"The opposition won in Hulu Selangor in 2008 because many fence-sitters were lured by promises, but they were disappointed when almost none was fulfilled."

The 1Malaysia People's Aid (BR1M) and other initiatives implemented by BN, he said, were introduced because there was a need.

"People regret their action in 2008. They are now convinced that the Najib (Datuk Seri Najib Razak) administration can bring about change and a better future."

He said Tun Daim Zainuddin's interview in the New Sunday Times was timely as people would realise that Najib was the best candidate to lead the country.

"He (Tun Daim) said that BN has a fair chance to win a two-thirds majority and preferred Najib as PM. He said the right thing at the right time."
