

Parliament not expected to convene next month

PETALING JAYA: The Dewan Rakyat is unlikely to convene for a meeting next month due to the insufficient notice given to MPs, said Dewan Rakyat Deputy Speaker Datuk Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar.

"Parliament is usually scheduled to sit in March and before we set the actual date, we will receive a list of government agendas, such as Bills to be debated or motions on specific issues.

"So far, there are no government agendas sent to Parliament," he said yesterday.

Wan Junaidi was asked to comment about the possibility of another Dewan Rakyat meeting as Parliament is expected to be automatically dissolved on April 28.

He also noted that there were no notices issued by Parliament to the MPs so far.
