

Johor Sultan Heads Terengganu Honours List

KUALA TERENGGANU, April 26 (Bernama) -- The Sultan of Johor, Sultan Ibrahim Ibni Almarhum Sultan Iskandar, heads a list of 324 people conferred awards and medals in conjunction with the 50th birthday of the Sultan of Terengganu, Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin, Thursday.

Sultan Ibrahim has been conferred the Darjah Kebesaran Kerabat Terengganu Yang Amat Mulia First Class (DK) award.

Three people have been conferred the Seri Paduka Mahkota Terengganu (SPMT) award which carries the title "Datuk". They are Terengganu State Secretary Datuk Mazlan Ngah; Inspector-General of Police Tan Sri Ismail Omar and Chief of Army Gen Tan Sri Zulkifli Zainal Abidin.

Two people have been conferred the Datuk Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin (DSMZ) award which also carries the title "Datuk" and "Toh Puan" for the wives. The recipients are High Court Judge Datuk Mohd Yazid Mustafa and Kuala Lumpur Chief Police Officer Datuk Mohamad Salleh.

Thirteen people have been conferred the Datuk Paduka Mahkota Terengganu (DPMT) award which also carries the title "Datuk" and "Toh Puan" for the wives. These recipients include Terengganu Infrastructure Development and Public Amenities Committee Chairman Datuk Za'abar Mohd Adib; former State Executive Councillor Asha'ari Idris and National Civics Bureau Director-General Datuk Raja Arif Raja Ali.

Other recipients of the DPMT award are Terengganu Public Works Director Shafii Mohamad; Terengganu Health Director Dr Anwa Sulaiman; Terengganu Library Corporation Director Nor Akmal Abdul Fatah; former Air Putih state assemblyman and Terengganu Orphans Welfare Organisation (Perkaya) vice-president Harun Hassan and the senior director of the Missionary, Education and Halal Management Department of the Terengganu Islamic Affairs and Malay Customs Council (Maidam), Samsiah Awang.

Two police officers who were killed in the recent armed intrusion in Lahad Datu, Sabah, were honoured posthumously. ASP Zulkifli Mamat of the police commando unit and ACP Ibrahim Lebar of the Special Branch, Bukit Aman, were among six people conferred the Setia Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin (SMZ) award.

Twenty-one people were conferred the Setia Mahkota Terengganu (SMT) award, and they include Terengganu Education Director Zakaria Hussin; Maidam Baitulmal Department Director Mohd Noor Mohamad; Petaling Jaya OCPD ACP Arjunaidi Mohamed; Penang Commercial Crime Investigation Department chief ACP Roslee Chik and Ikatan Muslimin Malaysia (ISMA) President Abdullah Zaik Abdul Rahman.

State Executive Councillor Dr A Rahman Mokhtar and Terengganu Social Welfare Director Zuhami Omar are among 26 people conferred the Ahli Sultan Mizan Zainal Abidin Terengganu (AMZ) award.

Thirty-six people were conferred the Ahli Mahkota Terengganu (AMT), and they include the Barisan Nasional (BN) candidate for the Kuala Terengganu parliamentary seat, Mohd Zubir

Embong.

Six people were conferred the Pingat Jasa Cemerlang (PJC); 18, the Pingat Bintang Lama Berjawatan (BLB); 169, the Pingat Jasa Kebaktian (PJK) and 23, the Pingat Lama Berjawatan (PLB).

Terengganu State Secretary Datuk Mazlan Ngah said the investiture would be held on July 7 and 9, and for the first time it would be held at the new palace in Bukit Chendering, Kuala Terengganu.
