

Najib Opens Seberang Takir 1Malaysia Rehabilitation Centre

KUALA TERENGGANU, May 1 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak Wednesday opened the 1Malaysia Rehabilitation Centre as part of his whirlwind tour in the Seberang Takir state constituency here.

The prime minister was accompanied by his wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, Terengganu Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Ahmad Said and Barisan Nasional (BN) candidate for the constituency Datuk Ahmad Razif Abdul Rahman.

The 1Malaysia Rehabilitation Centre, which began operations last month, provides treatment for chronic illnesses to local residents without having to visit the Sultanah Nur Zahirah Hospital.

Set up at the cost of RM1 million at the Umno Coordinator Building in Kampung Teluk Ketapang, Seberang Takir, the centre is the first of its kind in the peninsula and opens five days a week.

It provides free specialist treatment to about 80 people, who are down with chronic illnesses like stroke, heart ailments, kidney failure, diabetes and high blood pressure under the community-based centre programme.

Specialists at the centre are provided by the Sultanah Nur Zahirah Hospital with the permission of the Terengganu Health Department.
