

Tengku Adnan Can Retain Putrajaya, Say Indian Voters

PUTRAJAYA, May 1 (Bernama) -- Indian voters here will give their undivided support to Barisan Nasional (BN) candidate Datuk Seri Tengku Adnan Tengku Mansor to retain Putrajaya, the federal government administrative capital.

Putrajaya MIC division chief S. Kanappati said the Indian community fully realised that Tengku Adnan had a "golden heart" as he was concerned over Indians' welfare since 10 years ago.

"The 435 Indian voters in Putrajaya will not vote for the other candidate as we have personally seen Tengku Adnan working for the constituents here.

"He is also easily approachable and is a humble person," he said of Tengku Adnan, who is also Umno and BN secretary-general.

"I cannot see any reason for the constituents here not to support Tengku Adnan, who is defending Putrajaya, the federal government's administrative capital," he told reporters at a get-together with Indian voters, here.

Tengku Adnan won the Putrajaya seat in the 2008 general election by a 2,734-vote majority.

A retiree and voter, G. Gamo, said hundreds of people would queue up daily to meet Tengku Adnan to ask for various assistance.

Also, Putrajaya was never devoid of various activities beneficial for the people since Tengku Adnan became the Putrajaya member of parliament, said Gamo, who has been living in Putrajaya for 14 years.
