

PAS Needs To Prove BN Was Behind Provocative Banners - Ahmad Bashah

ALOR SETAR, April 22 (Bernama) -- The Kedah Barisan Nasional (BN) on Monday denied being involved with banners bearing a party logo and picture of an opposition leader, which were deemed to be provocative, and urged PAS to provide evidence on the allegations.

Kedah BN chairman Datuk Ahmad Bashah Ahmad Hanipah stressed that PAS cannot simply accuse the BN machinery of putting up the banners without showing evidence.

"Don't make wild accusations if there is no proof that BN is involved. We don't want to put up banners with logos or pictures of other party leaders, we're too busy putting up our own flags," he told reporters here.

He said BN had never been interested in such activities because they were fully focused on more serious matters such as helping the public.

He was commenting on a statement by Kedah PAS Election Department secretary, Zamri Ibrahim, that there were provocative banners put up by BN machinery which contained the party logo and picture of an opposition leader.

Ahmad Bashah said their election machinery had no time for such things as they wanted to use the campaign period to mingle with the community.
