

**Culprits In Ong's Murder Will Be Brought To Justice - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, April 23 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has given an assurance that the government would do its best to bring to justice, the culprits in last Saturday's senseless murder of a jogger in Bukit Gasing during a botched robbery.

"Like many others, I am shocked by the senseless murder of Irene Ong Ai Sam. We will do everything we can to bring her killers to justice," said the prime minister in his latest tweet today.

According to a local media report (thestar online), Selangor police chief Deputy Commissioner Datuk Tun Hisan Tun Hamzah confirmed that four suspects were detained in connection with the attempted hold-up and murder of Ong, 52.

The suspects, aged between 16-18, were detained by police at Flat Sri Medan and Flat Bukit Gasing Indah between 1am and 3am on Tuesday.

On Saturday, the victim was with her 17-year-old daughter when they were confronted by two youths wearing full-face helmets and armed with knives about 4.30pm.

Ong shouted to her daughter to run to safety and seek help from others in the area, while blocking the armed youths from grabbing the teenager from fleeing.

However, when the daughter returned to the scene with a man, they found Ong sprawled in a pool of blood.

She died on the way to the Universiti Malaya Medical Centre.
