

**Muhyiddin Officiates Foundation Laying Ceremony For Jerlun Sports Centre

JITRA, April 23 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today officiated at the foundation laying ceremony for the proposed Jerlun Sports Centre in Sanglang near here.

The project is the initiative of Barisan Nasional (BN) and a sign of the party's concern for the younger generation, particularly in the Jerlun parliamentary constituency which lacks such amenities, said Muhyiddin.

He said despite Kedah being under PAS rule, BN still cared for the people especially since they had not benefited from any development in the past five years.

"The state government is not capable of bringing progress, so we (BN) should take over and develop Kedah," he said.

The 10 hectare sports centre will be located next to Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan Sanglang and is estimated to cost more than RM3 million.

It will have a mini podium, jogging track, futsal court, playground and open field for the public.

More than 2,000 Jerlun residents attended the ceremony in support of yet another federal government project.
