

**80 Per Cent Kota Raja Parliamentary Constituency, BN White Area

KLANG, April 24 (Bernama) -- About 80 per cent of the Kota Raja parliamentary constituency is a white area for Barisan Nasional (BN) and the party is confident of turning the whole area white by the 13th general election on May 5.

The BN parliamentary candidate Kota Raja, Datuk S. Murugesan, who gave this information, said the BN machinery in the area was targeting to meet 105,909 voters before polling day. To date, it has met about 80,000 voters in the area.

"Feedback from voters thus far is positive and our machinery has explained to voters what BN is offering and the importance of voting for BN for a brighter future.

"We will endeavour to solve the problems faced by the area's residents which the opposition failed to do, including roads, floods and public security," he told reporters in Kampung Sungai Kandis, here, Wednesday.

Earlier, he launched a giant kite (wau) measuring 9.14 metres by 7.62 metres and covered with BN posters. The constituency's BN Youth took a day to complete the giant kite.

Other than the giant kite, they also produced a replica of a sailing ship, aeroplane and the Petronas Twin Towers which were also covered with BN posters.

Commenting on the work of the area's BN Youth, Murugesan said the innovative way of campaigning would boost BN's chances of defeating the opposition.

Murugesan will be involved in a four-cornered fight with incumbent Dr Siti Mariah Mahmud of PAS and two independents, P. Uthayakumar and Azman Idrus, on May 5.

In the GE12 in 2008, Siti Mariah won the seat with a 20,751-vote majority, beating BN candidate S. Vigneswaran.
