

DPM Happy With Acceptance Of BN Candidates

JOHOR BAHARU, April 24 (Bernama) - Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin is happy with the acceptance of Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates and want them to double efforts to reach out to the people.

"Response from the public and the voters towards BN candidates is encouraging and beyond expectation. Some even stated their support for BN openly.

"It is a good start and I hope that it will get better in the next ten days," he said at a meet-the-people session and offer of affordable housing to former residents of Rumah Rakyat Tampoi and residents of Denai Permai near here Wednesday.

The Deputy Prime Minister said the BN election machinery was moving smoothly and problems faced by the candidates had been resolved.

On the election machinery in areas of 61 Umno members sacked, he did not expect much problem as most were ordinary members with little influence in the party.

Muhyiddin said the Umno culture showed that members did not follow party leaders who quit as they remained loyal to the BN leadership.

Earlier, he presented offer letters for affordable housing to be built by Johor Land, a subsidiary of Johor Corporation (JCorp), to former residents of Rumah Rakyat Tampoi and residents of Denai Permai.

JCorp president and chief executive officer Datuk Kamaruzzaman Abu Kassim said it will build 304 affordable housing units valued at RM35,000 to RM80,000 each at a cost of RM28.2 million.
