

**GE13 Campaign Enforcement Team Takes Down Defamatory Materials**

KUALA TERENGGANU, April 24 (Bernama) -- The Kuala Terengganu (KT) 13th General Election (GE13) Campaign Enforcement Team has started taking down defamatory campaign materials put up by contesting parties in the city Wednesday.

Its chief, Mohd Huzairil Nizam Ibrahim said they had taken down flags, posters and banners put up at government buildings.

"As at yesterday, the team has also taken action on six of the cases.

"Some cases involved discussions with party representatives who agreed that the team should take down the campaign materials found to be violating the election regulations," he said when met at Jalan Pasir Panjang in Kuala Terengganu.

He said the team had been monitoring the campaign materials put up by the contesting parties ever since the nomination day on April 20 to ensure that they adhered to the laws.

"The seized materials will be kept in Kuala Terengganu City Council's store and the party representatives can reclaim them later," he said, adding that putting up defamatory election campaign materials was an offence under the Election Offences Act 1954.
