

Chinese Community Which Admits Najib Is The Best Leader Urged To Give Him Mandate

MUAR, April 25 (Bernama) -- The Chinese community which acknowledges Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak as the country's best leader now should translate their recognition as a mandate for Barisan Nasional (BN) in the May 5 polls, Umno Youth vice-chief Datuk Razali Ibrahim said.

He was confident that the prime minister would give more goodies to the people if given the mandate to administer the country after the general election.
