

**Chinese Support For BN In Perak Up - MCA President

GOPENG, April 25 (Bernama) -- Chinese support for the Barisan Nasional (BN) in Perak is on the rise following the failure of DAP's elected representatives to deliver the goods, said MCA president Datuk Seri Dr Chua Soi Lek. He said the Chinese community in Perak now understood the DAP had been taking them for granted so much so they (DAP) were looking at "more pastures". "They are of the view that Perak Chinese will support them no matter what. They are so confident that they are not even bothered to campaign in Perak. "They think they can defend their seats (in Perak) without having to provide any service. Unlike in Johor, where they are mustering everything they have to attack the BN," he said when performing the ground-breaking for the basketball court of Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan (Cina) Lawan Kuda Baru here Thursday. On another matter, Dr Chua said opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim was "daydreaming" that the Pakatan Rakyat (PR) can win six states in the 13th General Election on May 5. Yesterday, in an interview with Singapore's Channel News Asia, Anwar had claimed that PR would retain Penang, Kedah, Kelantan and Selangor, wrest back Perak and capture Negeri Sembilan in GE13.
