

**DPM, Wife Join Bukit Treh Voters For Breakfast**

MUAR, April 25 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin this morning spent time for breakfast with the residents of Kampung Bukit Treh, here.

He and his wife, Puan Sri Noorainee Abdul Rahman were greeted on arrival at about 9am by almost 100 residents.

Also present were the Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates for the Jorak state constituency Datuk Dr Sharuddin Md Salleh and the Bukit Serampang state constituency, Ismail Mohamed.

Speaking at the gathering, the Deputy Prime Minister, who will be defending the Pagoh parliamentary constituency, urged the people to give 100 per cent support to the BN during the May 5 election and ensure the survival of the existing government administration.

"There is no other choice but the BN to ensure the country's future. (Everyone) can look from our manifesto and efforts all this while which had been excellent and involved all strata of society," he said.

Muhyiddin said he was confident that many people would go to the polling centres to vote on May 5 in view of the many messages conveyed by the mass media.

"This is because there are songs on television telling the people to vote as well as messages in the press. I hope you will go out early in the morning to vote...if possible, after breakfast go to the polling centre," he said.

Muhyiddin said the election this time was very challenging, including in his own constituency which was being challenged by the candidate from the PKR for the first time.

He said the electorate in Pagoh should reject the attempt by the opposition to penetrate the area because of the negative elements in the party.
