

**Ahmad Said Urges PAS Hardcore Supporters To Wise Up**

MARANG, April 26 (Bernama) -- Terengganu Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman Datuk Seri Ahmad Said urged PAS hardcore supporters in the Rhu Rendang state assembly constituency to vote wisely so that the community does not remain in poverty.

Saying that the government always helped the residents there despite their rejection of BN due to being obsessed with PAS.

"The government has never sidelined them even though they're PAS supporters because they are still Malaysians and have a right to get assistance. But due to their obsession with the party some of them refuse our assistance.

"But they (PAS supporters) must know that Islam frowns on poverty, so they should reflect on what Hadi has done since he took over this place," he told reporters at the Kampung Paya futsal court after a visit here today.

The Rhu Rendang state seat has been a PAS stronghold from 1982 and this time around will see BN's Nik Dir Nik Wan Ku up against the party president Datuk Seri Abdul Hadi Awang.

"On the other hand there're also PAS supporters who accept our help but don't support us. They should think about bringing about a positive change here," he said.

Ahmad also advised all political party supporters in the state to be rational and not be too aggressive during the campaigning period in order to maintain public order and security.

"I hope all supporters be they BN, PAS or PKR will be rational during this general election. We're not going to war but only carrying out our duty as citizens," he said.
