

**N.Sembilan BN Launches Supplementary Manifesto**

SEREMBAN, April 26 ( Bernama) -- The Negeri Sembilan Barisan Nasional (BN) Friday launched its supplementary manifesto, entitled 'One Success One Appreciation, Promises Fulfilled', which contains 45 promises that it will fulfil should it get the mandate to administer the state in the May 5 polls.

The pledge was launched by deputy prime minister and BN deputy chairman Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin at a ceremony attended by about 2,000 guests, including BN leaders and candidates, at the Kampung FELDA Sendayan people's hall.

For the well-being of the people, the BN promised to achieve zero hardcore poverty, increase the number of affordable houses, implement more 1Malaysia public housing projects, expand free Wifi service, improve roads and build a modern hospital in Rembau.

To ensure the success of the Knowledge Valley Policy introduced by the state government, the BN promised to give incentives to those born in the state who obtain first class honours at institutions of higher learning.

Incentives to further education up to masters and doctoral levels would also be given and the Tahfiz Al-Quran Institute in Gemencheh would be upgraded.

The manifesto promised to resolve the gazette of 40 orang asli villages which had not been gazetted and to upgrade the orang asli economy to extend the success of the Social network Policy.

It promised to raise the quality of life of the urban folk by declaring Seremban as a city, upgrading several district councils to municipal councils and increasing the number of parking lots for the comfort of Seremban folk.

Attention was also given to strengthening the Islamic faith and inter-religious harmony, empowering volunteer patrols and community policing, efficient service and sound financial management and attracting more investments to create job opportunities.
