

Norashman Najib's Presence Enlivens Mood At Sekinchan Market

SUNGAI BESAR, April 26 (Bernama) -- Traders and customers at the Sekinchan market here Friday had a surprise visitor, the son of Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, Norashman.

The young man was there to accompany Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates Datuk Noriah Kasnon, who is contesting the Sungai Besar parliamentary seat, and Kek Seng Hooi, for the Sekinchan state seat, to promote the 1Malaysia concept.

The programme was organised by the Sekinchan Kochow Association and the Mew Wah kindergarten.

Norashman, 22, who is the prime minister's youngest son, arrived at the market about 7.30am and spent about an hour meeting and accepting greetings from trader and local residents there.
