

PM Arrives In Sarawak For Two-Day Visit

KUCHING, April 26 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak arrived at the Kuching International Airport at 9.25 tonight for a two-day visit to Sarawak, to cover areas such as Saratok, Lubok Antu, Kuching and Sibu.

Najib, who was accompanied by wife, Datin Seri Rosmah Mansor, was received by Chief Minister Tan Sri Abdul Taib Mahmud and wife, Puan Sri Ragad Kurdi Taib, as well as the state cabinet ministers and community leaders.

In line with the 13th General Election campaign, Najib has a tight schedule with several 'Leader with the People' sessions which are scheduled to start in Saratok town on Saturday morning.

According to the statement issued by the Prime Minister's Office, Najib will also attend the 'Leader with the People' Session in Rumah Awing Merindun, Lubok Antu before attending another similar programme in Dewan Masyarakat Kampung Semeba, Kuching.

Najib will later attend the opening of a school and the groundbreaking ceremony for a new block of Sekolah Jenis Kebangsaan Chung Hua No 2, Jalan Stutong in Kuching before ending his visit with another 'Leader with the People' session in front of Hotel Paramount, Jalan Kg Datuk in Sibu, before departing for Kuala Lumpur.
