

Government Scouting Suitable Site For New Transportation Terminal In Muar

MUAR, April 27 (Bernama) -- The government is looking for a suitable site for the proposed public transportation terminal project to replace the existing station in town.

Deputy Youth and Sports Minister Datuk Razali Ibrahim said that initially the project was to combine the express bus and stage bus stations in Jalan Maharani here and move them to the second route to Muar near Sabak Aur Jalan Salleh here.

"However, many parties did not agree with the proposal as it was too far from the town centre and the government decided to scout for a more suitable location for the bus terminal project," he said.

He was replying to a question raised by a Muar resident at a function to introduce Barisan Nasional (BN) candidates for the Muar parliamentary and Maharani state seats at a district polling centre in Jalan Mariam here Friday.

Present were BN Maharani candidate Datuk Zulkhairi Ahmad and Muar community leaders of various races.

Razali, who is the BN candidate for the Muar parliamentary seat, said the government would only proceed with the project when the location received the consensus of the people.

He gave the example of the 'up town' project in Jalan Sisi which was partially completed but could not operate due to protests by the residents.
