

MAICCI Distributes VCD On Najib's Aid For Indians

KLANG, April 27 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Associated Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (MAICCI) has begun distributing 1.5 million copies of a VCD depicting the programmes Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has introduced for the Indian community.

Entitled "Najib Harapan Masyarakat India" (Najib, the Hope of the Indian Community), the VCD contains the programmes implemented by Najib for the community from April 2009 when he took over as the prime minister.

MAICCI president Datuk K.K. Eswaran said the VCD was brought out to help the campaign of the Barisan Nasional (BN) in the 13th general election.

The distribution of the VCD was launched last night at a concert organised by the MAICCI at a Tamil school here. Also present at the event was the BN candidate for the Seri Andalas state seat, T. Mohan.

Eswaran said the 3.9-minute video explains the history of the nation's independence and all the efforts taken by Najib to resolve the problems faced by the Indian community in the country.

Mohan, who is MIC Youth chief, said the BN machinery had been deployed for door-to-door distribution of the VCD.
