

**People Reminded Not To Be Hoodwinked By Promises In Kelantan PAS' Manifesto

MACHANG, April 27 (Bernama) -- The Kelantan people are advised not to be misled by the 23 form of assistance promised under the oil royalty claim by the state Pas in its election manifesto.

State Barisan Nasional (BN) chairman Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said what was needed in Kelantan was a well-planned development plan to bring the state and its people on par with other states.

"It is improper for the state government to create a situation which leads the people to wish for something unreal and has no basis," he told reporters after a walkabout at the Machang Market here Saturday.

He was accompanied by BN candidate for Machang, Datuk Ahmad Jazlan Yaakub, and the candidates for the three state seats in the Machang parliamentary constituency, Eriandi Ismail (Kemuning), Azemi Mat Zin (Temangan) and Halim@Ab Halim Ismail (Pulai Chondong).

Mustapa said the opposition should not bring up the issue on the oil royalty in its election campaign as a special committee had been formed to study the matter.

BN, he said, had better plans to develop Kelantan if given the mandate.
