

**BN Prevents Disputes By Practising Wasatiyyah Concept, Says Abdul Ghani

JOHOR BAHRU, April 28 (Bernama) -- Unlike the opposition pact, Barisan Nasional (BN) has managed to prevent disputes among its component parties by practising the concept of wasatiyyah or moderation, Johor Menteri Besar Datuk Abdul Ghani Othman said.

"The BN has always practiced the wasatiyyah concept, which is an important foundation. In fact, the concept is also shared among all BN component parties, be it MCA, MIC or Gerakan.

"In the opposition pact, however, we can see that they have some negative perception of each other," he told reporters after meeting with Chinese voters at San San Kok Wang Temple in Kangkar Pulai here Sunday.

Abdul Ghani, who is contesting for the Gelang Patah parliamentary seat, said he would ensure that the people in the constituency would be able to meet with him to voice out their problems.

He said many important duties awaiting the elected representatives after the 13th general election and they must be available at their respective constituencies to serve the people.

Abdul Ghani, who had served as the state's chief executive for over 18 years, said meeting with the people was always his cup of tea.

Earlier, Abdul Ghani also went on a walkabout at Taman Ungku Tun Aminah, meeting with the Indian community in Taman Pulai Perdana, residents in Kampung Poh Chee Leng and Gelang Patah Wanita in Taman Universiti.
