

PAS Candidate For Lenggeng In Hospital After Stroke, Says Negeri Sembilan Youth Chief

SEREMBAN, April 28 (Bernama) -- Zulkefly Mohamad Omar, the PAS candidate for the Lenggeng state seat, was admitted to a hospital Saturday after he is believed to have suffered a stroke, according to Negeri Sembilan PAS Youth chief Mohd Khairul Anuar Wafa.

Mohd Khairul said today Zulkefly, 49, was admitted to the Intensive Care Unit (ICU) of a hospital in Kuala Lumpur but he did not know which hospital it was or when he was taken to hospital.

"I was just informed that Zulkefly is in the ICU, but I am not sure which hospital it is," he said when contacted.

Zulkefly is involved in a three-cornered contest for the Lenggeng seat with Datuk Ishak Ismail of the Barisan Nasional and Zulkifli Abdullah, an independent.
