

## **Government Mulls Insurance Scheme For Enforcement Personnel**

SEPANG, April 29 (Bernama) -- The government will consider implementing a special insurance scheme to protect civil servants in enforcement positions, Chief Secretary to the Government Datuk Seri Dr Ali Hamsa said today.

He said the matter was raised in a recent meeting with the representatives of enforcement departments.

"It will be discussed in depth with the Public Service Department, Finance Ministry and related agencies to determine how it can be implemented," he said before launching the Malaysian Health Tourism Council's one-stop health centre at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport here today.

Ali said the move was aimed at motivating enforcement personnel to carry out their duties with more confidence.

At present their next-of-kin receive compensation and pension if a death occurs during the course of work.

An estimated 400,000 enforcement personnel will benefit from the scheme if it is implemented.
