

**Muhyiddin Calls On Felda Community To Continue Supporting BN

LABIS, April 29 (Bernama) -- Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin on Monday called on the Felda community in the country to continue giving their support to the Barisan Nasional (BN) to drive their development further.
