

**Najib Wants People Of Johor To Safeguard Cradle Of Modern Malaysian History**

PONTIAN, April 29 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak on Monday called on the people of Johor to safeguard the state, the cradle of modern Malaysian history, from people whom he referred to as power-crazy and incompetent administrators.
