

PM, DPM To Meet People In Terengganu On Wednesday, Thursday

KUALA TERENGGANU, April 29 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak is expected to arrive in Terengganu tomorrow night to provide a boost to the Barisan Nasional (BN) electoral campaign in the state on Wednesday, said Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Ahmad Said.

He said Najib would begin the campaign by having breakfast with the people in the Bukit Tunggal state constituency and then present excellence awards in Kampung Bukit Wan before addressing the people of Batu Rakit here.

"The prime minister will also meet with the Kuala Terengganu Relia members at Stadium Negeri and residents in the fishermen's village in Mengabang Tengah before heading back to Kuala Lumpur," he said.

Ahmad spoke to reporters at the handing over of remuneration to 561 executive information officers (EIO) and technical support officers (TSO) at the convention hall of the Islamic Civilisation Park, here.

Ahmad, who is also Terengganu BN chairman, said Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin would arrive in Terengganu on Thursday to meet the people in Dungun and to officially open the Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Seri Payong in Bukit Payong, Marang.
