

Muhyiddin In Kelantan Wednesday

KOTA BAHARU, April 30 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin who will be making a one-day visit to Kelantan Wednesday, is expected to rally Barisan Nasional (BN) supporters to go all out to wrest the state from PAS come polling day in the 13th General Election on May 5.

Kelantan BN chief Datuk Seri Mustapa Mohamed said Muhyiddin was scheduled to first open a RM15-million new bridge in Kampung Manek Urai Baru, Kuala Krai which was a promise made by the BN during the Manek Urai by-election in 2009.

Following that, Muhyiddin is scheduled to travel to Jeli to attend a 1Malaysia people's gathering at Sekolah Kebangsaan Gemang, Ayer Lanas.

Thereafter, Muhyiddin will attend another 1Malaysia people's gathering in Bachok before flying back to Kuala Lumpur.

Mustapa said Muhyiddin would delivering important messages to the people of Kelantan at both the gatherings.
