

**BN man wants cops to probe PKR man for gift of tea to MCA staff**

KUALA LUMPUR, April 23 — A Barisan Nasional (BN) candidate for a state seat in Pahang has lodged a complaint with the police after a rival from PKR gave the former's staff two packets of herbal tea, according to a report in The Star Online.

It is unclear what crime had been committed, but according to the report Teruntum BN candidate Datuk Chang Hong Seong lodged a police report over two packets of herbal tea given to his Kuantan MCA staff by the PKR man.

He said PKR's Semambu candidate Lee Chean Chung and five others came to Wisma MCA in Kuantan on Monday and presented the packets to his campaign workers.

"I am very bothered by his action which is unhealthy and may cause provocation as well as unwanted reactions during the general election campaign period.

"I want the Election Commission to investigate whether Lee has broken any rules.

"We are also asking the police to warn Lee about his action," said Chang as reported by The Star.

According to the report, Chang also questioned Lee's intention, pointing out that the latter was not even contesting in the Kuantan parliamentary constituency.

"Lee is a candidate in the Indera Mahkota parliamentary constituency. Why did he come to Kuantan just to give us some herbal tea?"

When contacted by The Star, Lee said he was just trying to motivate Chang's staff so they would have the stamina to continue campaigning.

"It is a very simple gesture of concern by my team for our opponents. I also sent some tea to Barisan's candidate for Semambu, Datuk Pang Tsu Ming, but it was rejected. I will leave it to the public to judge," he said.
