

On the stump in Anwar's seat, Muhyiddin tells voters to go back to BN

PERMATANG PAUH, April 23 - Caretaker Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin told voters here to go back to Barisan Nasional (BN) and not be duped by what he claimed were their MP and Opposition leader Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim's lies.

"I know this is his stronghold with many of his supporters here but I want all of you to realise that he's been feeding you lies so you should stop from being duped any further," he said in his speech at the launch of the Seberang Jaya Community College here.

Labelling Anwar a power-crazy leader with only one goal – that of becoming Prime Minister – Muhyiddin said he had no choice but to expose Anwar's real motives, which was to become Prime Minister and not to develop the nation for the people.

The Umno deputy president alleged that the Pakatan Rakyat (PR) manifesto would definitely bankrupt the whole country if it was given federal power.

"The caretaker Penang chief minister Lim Guan Eng has said I am going around scaring people but I want to say that I have no choice as I need to tell people the truth behind their manifesto," he said.

He said the PR manifesto of abolishing tolls, reducing petrol prices and abolishing repayment of PTPTN loans will cause the country's deficit to increase.

"Our deficit is now only 4.5 per cent but if they take over and implement their manifesto, our deficit will go up to 11 per cent and this will definitely bankrupt the nation," he said.

He expressed his sympathy to Anwar for losing sight of the interest of the nation in trying to achieve his dream of becoming the next Prime Minister.

"All he knows now is to eat, sleep, dream of going to Putrajaya and nothing else," he said.

He called on all Permatang Pauh voters to look through Anwar's deception and vote BN during the polls this May 5.

Earlier, he launched the community college and said the community college is one of BN's initiatives to create life-long learning education hubs for the people that had created many successful entrepreneurs.
