

Tea gift to MCA just to show support, says PKR man

KUALA LUMPUR, April 23 – PKR’s Semambu candidate Lee Chean Chung said today that he gave herbal tea to Kuantan MCA staff merely to show support during Election 2013.

Datuk Chang Hong Seong, who is Barisan Nasional’s (BN) candidate for the Teruntum state seat in Pahang, had lodged a police report against Lee, saying that the latter’s action may “cause provocation”, according to The Star Online today.

“I’m not sending radioactive waves from Lynas; I’m only sending two bags of herbal tea,” Lee told The Malaysian Insider today, referring to the controversial Lynas rare earth plant in Kuantan.

“I don’t expect such a negative perception towards that,” added the PKR candidate for the Semambu state seat in Pahang.

Chang reportedly said that Lee and five others came to Wisma MCA in Kuantan on Monday and presented two packets of herbal tea to his campaign workers.

Chang also questioned Lee’s intention, pointing out that the latter was not even contesting in the Kuantan parliamentary constituency.

Lee said that he would be giving herbal tea to his colleagues and would also distribute it in the morning market tomorrow, pointing out that Chang’s reaction was “the joke of the day”.
