

**Give Najib Time To Decide On New Cabinet Members - Salang

BINTANGOR, May 10 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak should not be pressured by any unnecessary demand from the people into deciding who needed to be included in his new cabinet line-up.

Julau Member of Parliament Datuk Joseph Salang said it was best that Najib be given time to decide.

"With the Grace of God, perhaps, he will come up with the best judgement and proper wisdom to make the right choice of candidates for inclusion in his new cabinet," he said.

Salang was speaking to the media today after hosting a thank-you luncheon and presenting 1Malaysia netbooks to more than 250 of his election workers and officials at a restaurant here.

According to local newspapers, his supporters hope he be made a full minister after winning - again with very convincing majority - for a fourth term.

At the same time, supporters of other successful Barisan Nasional candidates had, today and yesterday, made similar press statements, urging Najib to consider their respective representatives for full ministership.

On his plans for Julau, Salang, who is also information, communication and culture deputy minister, said there were four main areas that he would look into.

They were:

- * improving basic infrastructures like roads;
- * supplying more areas with treated water;
- * improving communication and internet coverages; and,
- * opening up land for oil palm and rubber cultivation.
