

**No Way Voters From Elsewhere Can Be Brought To Vote In Selangor - EC

KUALA LUMPUR, April 30 (Bernama) -- Election Commission (EC) chairman Tan Sri Abdul Aziz Mohd Yusof said today it was impossible to bring voters from elsewhere to vote in Selangor in the 13th General Election, polling for which is on Sunday.

He said all voters had to adhere to a procedure if they wanted to vote in another constituency.

They would have to inform the EC of a change in their address and their names on the electoral rolls would be displayed for two weeks for objections, if any, before the change could be gazetted, he told reporters after visiting the polling centre for early voting at the Police Training Centre (Pulapol) here.

Yesterday, Selangor Menteri Besar and state Pakatan Rakyat chairman Tan Sri Abdul Khalid Ibrahim alleged that Umno had flown in voters from elsewhere, especially Sabah.
