

**Police Monitoring Blogs Citing Parties Planning Polls Violence - Muhyiddin

KLUANG, April 30 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin said today he believed the police were monitoring several blogs which stated that certain political parties were planning to create trouble during the general election on Sunday.

He said they were talking even about people entering polling centres and rejecting the ballot papers if they were not happy with what the presiding officers were doing.

"We are aware and anticipate this because there have been statements by supporters of certain parties that they would resort to this.

"The purpose is to raise tension and, when there is trouble, they would record it on video and circulate it to accuse the Election Commission of being unfair and that the police had assaulted them," he told reporters after attending a 1Malaysia gathering in Layang-Layang here.

Also present at the event were Muhyiddin's wife, Puan Sri Noorainee Abd Rahman, Deputy Defence Minister Datuk Dr Abdul Latiff Ahmad and Simpang Renggam BN chairman Abdul Hamid Abdul Rahman.
