

**Muhyiddin Calls On 13.2 Million Voters To Come Out And Vote On Sunday**

LEDANG, May 4 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin today called on the country's 13.2 million eligible voters to carry out their duty by coming out to vote in the 13th general election tomorrow.

He said the cooperation of voters from all races was much needed to give victory to the Barisan Nasional (BN), hence the first mandate for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak.

"I am confident that the 'rakyat' (people) now know the prime minister and the policy that he has implemented, that is, 'People First, Performance Now' which has had a big impact on the country," he said after a reception with the settlers community of Felda Sri Ledang, here, today.

Also present were Muhyiddin's wife Puan Sri Noorainee Abd Rahman and BN candidate for the Bukit Serampang state seat, Ismail Mohamed.

Muhyiddin said a win for BN was crucial for the country to continue with the transformation policies already implemented, considering that the next five years would be a very important period for Malaysia to achieve developed-nation status.

He said the government wanted all the plans drawn up to be on the right track and a change of government would definitely retard the development that was going on.

"I hope the voters will be rational because this general election outcome will determine our country's future.

"If (they are) confident with BN's capability, they should support BN. If not, it's up to them. No one will force anyone to support any political party," he added.
