

Muhyiddin Starts Final Campaign Day By Having Breakfast With The People

LEDANG (Johor), May 4 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin began the final campaign day today of the 13th General Election by having breakfast with the people at the Gerai Kebun Baru food court here.

He arrived at 9.20 am by a helicopter which landed in the compound of the Kebun Baru police station located across the food court.

About 200 people, the majority of them Chinese, had gathered enthusiastically to listen to Muhyiddin's speech and express their support for the Barisan Nasional (BN).

The BN deputy chairman said he hoped that the people would not be deceived by the last-minute efforts of Pakatan Rakyat to smear the image of the BN.

"The people's support (for the BN) is still strong despite the opposition's attempts to tarnish the image of the BN. I hope the people are not deceived," he said.

Muhyiddin, who is defending the Pagoh parliamentary seat, said he feared that the DAP would raise racial sentiments which could undermine the cordial relations among the communities.

"We have been here in Malaysia for a long time and we know that the Malays, Indians, Chinese and Orang Asli here (in Pagoh) are united and have no problems among them," he said.

He also said that amenities, including houses, schools and trading outlets, in Kebun Baru would be improved. Also present at the event was the BN candidate for the Bukit Serampang state seat, Ismail Mohamed.
