

Muhyiddin, Wife Cast Vote Early At SMK Sri Muar

MUAR, May 5 (Bernama) -- Deputy Prime Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin casts his vote at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Sri Muar, Jalan Meriam, here Sunday.

Clad in blue batik shirt, Muhyiddin arrived at the school at 8.10am and was among the earliest voters who voted at the polling centre which opened at 8am.

Muhyiddin (pic), who is defending his Pagoh parliamentary seat in the 13th general election, was accompanied by his wife, Puan Seri Noorainee Abd Rahman, who also casts her vote at the school.

Both of them completed the voting process at 8.20am and spent some time posing for photographers while showing off their index fingers marked with the indelible ink.

The tussle for the Pagoh parliamentary seat is between Muhyiddin and Mohamad Rozali Jamil of PAS.

In the 2008 polls, Muhyiddin won the seat by defeating Mohamad Rozali with 12,581-vote majority.

Muhyiddin and his wife later took a ride to witness the voting process at several polling stations from Muar through to Temiang, Pagoh, Lenga and right up to Bukit Kepong.

He dropped by at the polling stations at Sekolah Menengah Kebangsaan (SMK) Sultan Alauddin Riayat Shah 1, Pekan Pagoh and Sekolah Kebangsaan LKTP Felda Batu 27, Lenga.

He ended his three-hour journey at a polling station at Sekolah Kebangsaan Kota Raja, Panchor.
