

**BN Members Of Parliament Must Double Efforts - Najib

KUALA LUMPUR, May 7 (Bernama) - Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak has urged Barisan Nasional (BN) members of parliament (MP) to double efforts to win over young voters and the Chinese community.

Najib, who is also BN chairman urged the MPs to win over voters in urban areas as preparation for the 14th general election (GE14).

BN also found that urban issues were given less attention during campaign compared to rural areas, Pasir Salak MP Datuk Tajuddin Abdul Rahman told reporters after the Prime Minister's special briefing with BN MPs at Putra World Trade Centre here Tuesday.

Muar MP Datuk Razali Ibrahim said the Prime Minister also urged the BN MPs to work hard for the people and reminded them not to be complacent with the win.

Putatan MP Datuk Dr Marcus Makin Mojigoh said the Prime Minister also want them find to better methods and to be ready for GE14.

"We have to get ready to form a more stable government that will increase the confidence of the people," he added.
