

Raja Muda Visits Rumah Sejahtera On Bicycle

PADANG BESAR, May 9 (Bernama) -- The Raja Muda of Perlis, Tuanku Syed Faizuddin Putra Jamalullal Thursday cycled 15 kilometres to visit Rumah Sejahtera in Kampung Batu Bertangkup near here.

He started off from the Batu Bertangkup small-and-medium industry zone and visited some traditional villages before arriving at Rumah Sejahtera.
