

**Still A Large Number Of Malaysian Chinese Support BN Govt - Gerakan

KUALA LUMPUR, May 13 (Bernama) -- There is still a large number of Malaysian Chinese who support the Barisan Nasional (BN) government, said Kedah Gerakan Youth chief, Tan Keng Liang.

Therefore it was grossly misleading to create a false perception of all Malaysian Chinese had betrayed the Malay community as there were also people from the Malay community who supported the opposition, he said in a statement in Kuala Lumpur, Monday.

Tan said this in referring to the statement by former Court of Appeal Judge, Mohd Noor Abdullah Sunday who warned that Malaysian Chinese must be prepared for a backlash from the Malay community for their 'betrayal' in the recently concluded 13th General Election.

"As a current member of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) complaints committee, Mohd Noor should refrain from making any statement that will cause uneasiness among Malaysians after the election," Tan said.

He said the general election was a democratic process where any Malaysian could choose whichever party they wished to vote for and that the choice was not an act of betrayal towards any political party or community.
