KUCHING, May 15 (Bernama) -- Former Dewan Rakyat deputy speaker Datuk Dr Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar, 66, is the new Deputy Home Minister.

Wan Junaidi, who was a police officer in the 1960s has vast experience, being an assistant officer in charge of traffic in 1967 to Platoon Commander of the Police Field Force and finally as the Chief Prosecuting Officer in 1982.

A person who never rests on his laurels, the Santubong Member of Parliament has been upgrading his education from Junior certificate from Stamford College Singapore in 1975 to a doctorate in Business Administration from Southern California University for Professional Studies in 2004.

Wan Junaidi also received his law degree with 2nd class honours from the University of Buckingham, England and Barrister-at-Law with second class honour from Lincoln's Inn, London.

Chief Scout Commissioner of the Scout Association Sarawak Branch since 1992, he first contested in the 1990 General Election in the Batang Lupar Parliamentary seat and in the 2004 General Election moved to Santubong.
