

Religious Enforcement Agencies Must Be Active - Jamil Khir

PUTRAJAYA, May 21 (Bernama) - Religious enforcement agencies nationwide must be more active in enforcing the law, especially cases related to false teachings.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Datuk Seri Jamil Khir Baharom said they should cooperate with other parties such as the police and the Immigration Department.

"Don't wait until there are many reports as by then, action can't be implemented because the agencies database is not updated," he told reporters after addressing officers of agencies under his responsibility in Putrajaya, Tuesday.

He said action should be based on information received during the weekly meeting between the Islamic Development Department (JAKIM) and the Home Affairs Ministry.
