

**BN Selangor Must Prepare For Next General Election From Now - Noh

TANJUNG KARANG, May 25 (Bernama) -- The Selangor Barisan Nasional (BN) should devise a strategy to prepare for the next general election, including restructuring the party's state leadership, said deputy chairman Datuk Seri Noh Omar.

He opined that the state BN should have only the main leader to manage and administer its state political affairs.

"It is hard to issue instructions when there are two or three chiefs, so we should have only one," he told a media conference after closing the Integrated Knowledge and Cultural Development Programme for the fishing community at Kampung Parit 3, Sungai Burung here Saturday.

The programme was organised by Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM).

Noh also said there was a need to strengthen unity among the state BN leaders to gain the confidence of supporters and the people in Selangor.

"We have to concede that weaknesses and internal problems within the party were among the reasons for Selangor BN's defeat in the 13th General Election; thus, to face the next election, we have to be prepared from today," he noted.

Noh, who is also Tanjong Karang member of parliament, said that should the top BN leadership decide to appoint a new face to lead Selangor BN, he would fully support the new leader.
